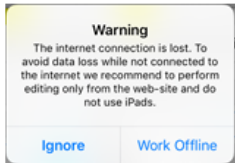
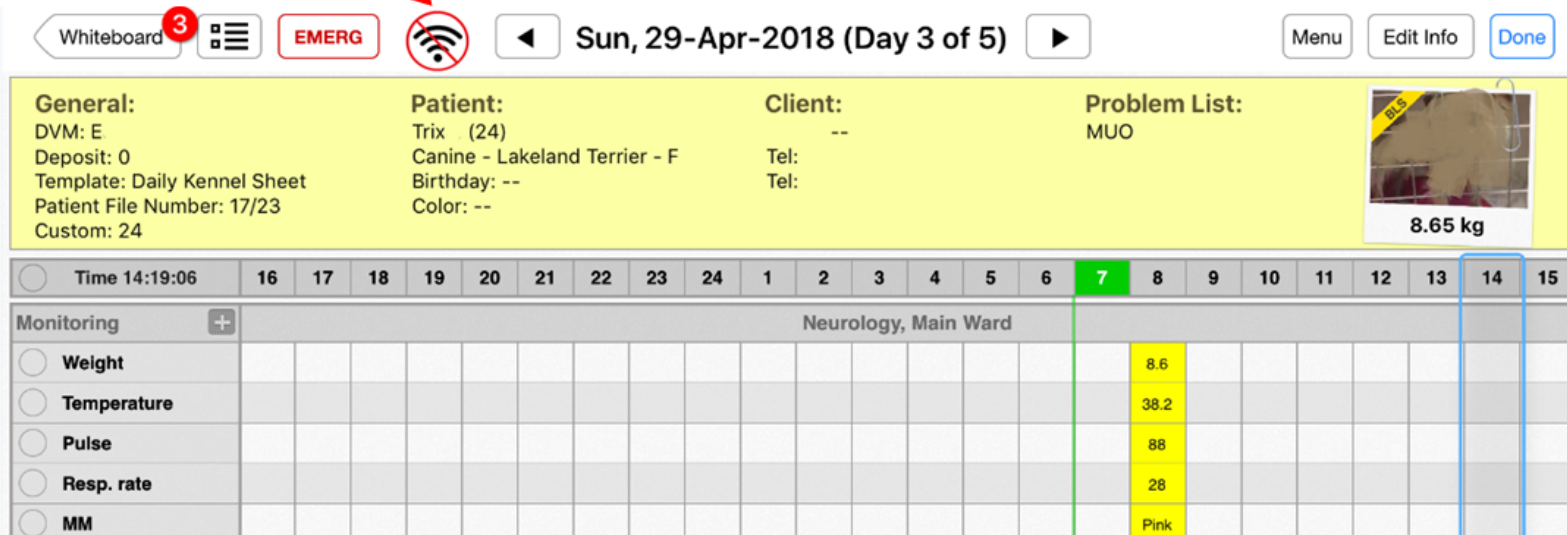


Working offline mode alert

In addition to the pop-up box, there should be an ongoing visual notice on the iPad screen to alert the user that they are working offline/the iPad isn't connected to the internet.



Either a no-wifi symbol could be displayed on the iPad or a 'Working offline' written notice could be displayed (similar to 'Editing mode').
